Biography

Robert Ellsworth Green (1911-1991) served as a pastor in the Methodist church for 34 years. He married Dorothea Scott (1920-2000) and the two served as pastor and wife for three years while he attended Boston University School of Theology, 1930-1932. His BU Master's thesis is entitled "Hosea's Conception of God." After his education was completed, he and his wife moved to Indiana where they served churches in the Indiana Conference of the Methodist Church and the South Indiana Conference of the United Methodist Church, which Robert Green also served as Secretary. His appointments included churches in Evansville, Boonville, Mount Vernon, Jeffersonville, Belford, Greenwood, Franklin and Indianapolis. In 1961 the Greens were delegates to the World Methodist Conference in Oslo. Dorothea Scott Green became a member of the Dr. Martin Luther King Essay Committee in 1973, and was appointed to the Indiana Governor's Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. State Holiday Commission and the Indiana Advisory Committee to the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights. She served as Secretary, Vice president and President of the South Indiana Conference of United Methodist Women. As President she served as a trustee of Methodist Hospital and as a Director of the Franklin United Methodist Home. Bishop Rueben Mueller appointed her to the General Board of the National Council of Churches. In 1972 she was the first woman elected as first delegate to the General Conference of her church. From 1972 to 1976 she served on the General Council of Ministries (the church's governing body) and as Chairman of the Committee on Communications. During these years she was a member of the Committee on the Episcopacy. In 1974 she was the first woman elected to be president of the Indiana Council of Churches. In 1976 she was elected as a delegate to the North Central Jurisdiction Conference and was a member of the Board of Global Ministries, the Commission on Ecumenical and Interreligious Concerns and the Indiana Area Commission on Communications. Among her many honors, she received the Brotherhood Award from the National Council of Christians and Jews in 1975; the Community Service Award from the Church Federation of Greater Indianapolis in 1990; the Roy Wilkins Individual Award in 1993, and the Service to Mankind Award for 1996-1997 from the Tri-County Sertoma Club. She also was named an Unsung Hero by the Indiana University Center on Philanthropy in 1999.

Scope and Content

This is a collection of the sermons of Robert E. Green who served as a pastor in the Methodist church for 34 years. Included are the Bulletins from Wall Street Methodist Church, Jeffersonville, Indiana from 1955 to 1957; First Methodist Church, Bedford, Indiana from 1958 to 1961; Grace Methodist Church, Franklin, Indiana from 1958 to 1965; First Methodist, Mount Vernon, Indiana from June 1966 to 1968; First United Methodist, Sullivan from 1968 to 1971; United Methodist, Fortville from 1971 to 1973 and Mt. Olive United Methodist Church from 1973 to 1977. In addition there are papers documenting events attended by the Greens as well as a twenty page history of Main Street Methodist Episcopal Church, 1839-1939.

Arrangement

The collection is arranged in three series as follows:

Series 1: Biographical papers documenting events attended by the Greens, their areas of service and a twenty page history of Main Street Methodist Episcopal Church. (Box 1)

Series 2: Sermons, arranged chronologically and according to the Church in which they were preached. Most sermons were inserted into the Bulletin for that day's service. (Box 2-6)

Series 3: Bulletins to which no sermon was attached, arranged in chronological order. (Box 7)
