Biography

Evelyn Jensen served Fuller as the Director of Academic Advising and Adjunct Assistant Professor of Women's Missiological Studies in the School of World Mission. The courses she taught were related to the specific needs of both American and international women who were involved in pre-service or mid-career cross-cultural ministries. She used informal support groups, counseling, and classes to empower women to fulfill God's call for their lives. She was one of the first women to challenge and insist that the School of World Mission faculty fully recognize the women who contributed to the development of God's mission enterprise throughout history. She, along with four other women in 1986 and 1987, planned and developed the first course for SWM on the issues of women in cross-cultural mission. Evelyn was the first woman to teach a course on the concerns of women in Christian mission at the School of World Mission. In addition, she served as the president of the Southern California chapter of Christians for Biblical Equality. Her work paved the way for other women and men to teach and develop various programs at Fuller.
