Biography

Jack and Anna Kerr are longtime pillars of the First Presbyterian Church of Hollywood. Jack's family moved from Pittsburgh to Long Beach in 1925 and then to Hancock Park about 1936. The family's pastor at the Long Beach Methodist Church, Pastor Inwood, recommended they attend the church of a friend, Stuart MacLennan, who was pastor of the First Presbyterian Church of Hollywood. The Kerr family agreed that FPCH was an excellent church and stayed. When the new pastor, Louis Evans came to First Press, the family moved into the Kerrs' neighborhood and young Jack was a big favorite with Mother Evans, Pastor Evan's mother. Her heart was with the poor and she often preached on street corners. Jack was later to follow in her footsteps with a ministry on skid row. Jack's father, Arthur Neal Kerr, discovered butane and propane and started a liquified petroleum business. His company was called Imperial Gas.

Anna's family moved from Texas to Los Angeles during the Depression. They stayed with an aunt and uncle because there was no work for her engineer father. The earthquake (1933) opened up jobs and her father, Clinton Linus August Borkemohle, was able to work again. He was a civil, architectural, and structural engineer. One of his impressive buildings was the Los Angeles Union Passenger Terminal (called the Union Station). Another was the original Disney Studios in Burbank, and a third was cantilever hangars at both Los Angeles and New York airports. The Borkemohle family was part of Presbyterian congregations in Amarillo, Texas, Long Beach and Huntington Park and Coronado CA. Anna's father, brother, and numerous cousins served as elders and she started as a Sunday school teacher when she was in the 7th grade; a Kindergarten class. By the time she finished high school she taught 5th and 6th graders. When Anna was a teen she heard of the great college department at First Press and began attending, traveling by bus each Sunday morning, usually arriving too late to get a seat inside. But she listened to Henrietta Mears from the courtyard and was struck by her message as well as by her manner.

When the Kerrs were married they naturally attended First Press together and began to develop their ministry skills there. In 1961 they were part of the Tokyo Christian Crusade in Japan. Dick Halverson, Bill and Vonette Bright, and six men from their Sunday School class were part of this outreach and invited many Japanese to go to the crusade each night. Bob Pierce spoke and there was a translator for him. There was a 500 voice choir and a 200 piece orchestra also. An industrialist named Mr. Shimamura became a Christian, and a young man named Bob Matsuo as well. While in Japan Anna visited schools and Jack went to engineering firms in the daytime.

Jack used his writing skills to write plays for the congregation, served as a Deacon, then an Elder and was on the search team which found Lloyd Ogilvie. Anna developed longstanding relationships with women prayer partners, served as a Deacon, then an Elder and took over the Missions department when the last pastor with that position left in 1994. She also leads the Women's' Ministry, organizing an annual conference called Faithlift. Anna and Jack have been on many short term mission trips. They went to Ecuador to photograph the work of Dr. Dilworth who was a medical missionary among the Quichua Indians in 1956, shortly after the 5 missionaries were killed by the Aucas. They made a project of showing slides and speaking to various churches and civic groups and raised funds to build a hospital and furnish it. Later Dr. Dilworth took a Masters at the School of World Mission under Dr. McGavran. Anna helped revise his thesis and Jack recently attended Dr. Dilworth's 90th birthday in Escondido.

The Kerrs have helped organize short term mission groups for many years. In 1996, 1998, and 2003 they were part of groups which served at Embangweni Hospital in Malawi, under the auspices of Medical Benevolence Foundation.

Scope and Content

The collection contains correspondence, printed material, poems and plays, photos, digital images, audio and video recordings document the backgrounds and ministries of Jack and Anna Kerr, pillars of the First Presbyterian Church of Hollywood.
