MORAL AND SPIRITUAL VALUES IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS. Decisions are now in the making on Senate Bill 1152, an act to add to the Education Code an article on moral instruction:

"8295. To aid in developing those higher moral standards necessary for good citizenship; materials that will promote and encourage moral and spiritual values including selections from the Bible which may be used in the public schools.

"8296. The State Board of Education shall publish a syllabus of materials that will promote and encourage moral and spiritual values including selections from the Bible which shall be made available to all public schools."
