Biography

Jackson Burton Wilcox (b. June 16, 1918 – d. November 14, 2013) was an American Baptist pastor, artist, writer, and editor with a ministry career spanning over six decades. He served in eleven churches, including St. Paul, MN; Aberdeen, WA; Chowchilla, CA; Santa Cruz, CA; Lindsay, CA; Hollywood, CA; Panorama City, CA; and Quartz Hill, CA. His ministry included illustrating published church newsletters and the underground newspaper *Hollywood Free Paper* for the Jesus People Movement with his distinctive cartoons and drawings.

His wife, Marjorie Wilcox, worked as secretary to Duane Pederson, editor of the *Hollywood Free Paper*. On September 1, 2003, he and Marjorie completed 62 years of ministry (including one year as national director of junior high work). His wife Marjorie passed away in October 2003. They had four children.

Jackson Wilcox was born on an estate at the foot of Echo Mountain in Altadena, California. His father, Burton Wilcox, was the son of William Cullen and Idabelle Wilcox, pioneer missionaries in South Africa. His mother was Ethel Ruth Angel Jackson, the daughter of George and Florence Jackson. The Jacksons were members of Tremont Baptist Church in Pasadena when Cull Wilcox needed funds to return to South Africa.

Jackson Wilcox graduated from the University of Redlands with a Bachelor's degree, the Colgate Rochester Divinity School with a Masters in Divinity, and the Eastern College with a Doctorate in Divinity. He was ordained in 1943 at the First Baptist Church in Williamson, NY.

Following brief periods as a writer with Western Personnel Service and as a Deputy Probation Officer with Los Angeles County, the First Baptist Church of Pasadena licensed Wilcox to preach. At this church, he and Marjorie Robbins of San Gabriel, California, were married. After a short ministry at Sunnyside Baptist Church in Los Angeles, they traveled to New York.

In 1943, Jackson was ordained at the First Baptist Church in Williamson, NY; it became his first pastorate. His ministry included the pastorate of Park Baptist Church in St. Paul, Minnesota; and two pastorates in Washington State: Camas and Aberdeen. Pastorates in California followed: First Baptist, Chowchilla; First Baptist, Santa Cruz; First Baptist, Lindsay; First Baptist, Hollywood; Panorama Baptist, Pacoima; and Mayflower Church, Quartz Hill.

As a cartoonist and writer, Wilcox produced textbooks, study courses, newspaper and magazine articles and columns. In 1983, he launched *Silver Wings*, a small non-profit poetry quarterly. He was working on the one hundred and fifty-sixth edition at the time of his passing.

This collection provides a unique window into the American Baptist church during the mid-to-late 20th century as well as the Jesus People Movement heritage and its continued influence.

Scope of Content

The collection primarily covers the latter half of the 20th century, from the 1939 to 2010. The principal focus of the collection is the writings and newsletters of Jackson Wilcox. Formats in the collection are diverse. They include cartoons, church newsletters, scrapbooks of Wilcox's newspaper columns, notes for Wilcox's sermons, a DVD, digital recordings of oral histories, and periodicals.

Also see the *Hollywood Free Paper* (in Duane Pederson, Jesus People International, and Hollywood Free Paper Collection, or the Archived Periodicals), for Jackson Wilcox's printed cartoons. Photos of his wife, Marjorie Wilcox, are included in the Pederson Collection.

Arrangement and Series Description

The collection has been organized in 10 boxes consisting of 2 series as follows:

Series I: Church Newsletters (Box 1-3)

These include newsletters published by Jackson Wilcox at the many churches he served as pastor from 1952 to 2003.

Series II: Other Writings (Box 2, 4-5)

These include Bible study guides, newsletters written for organizations such as the Kiwanis Club, newspaper columns, histories of various churches, devotionals, travel diaries, poetry, sermons, promotional and autobiographical items.

Cataloger Notes:

In Fall 2020, the collection experienced water damage from flooding within the Library. Materials underwent preservation treatment, including the transition to new folders and boxes.
